A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AT THE
UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT CHAPEL HILL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
Governors of The University of North Carolina, as a Bicentennial Gift from the People
of North Carolina, the sum of twenty-eight million one hundred thousand dollars
(\$28,100,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to be allocated to the University of North
Carolina at Chapel Hill as follows:

- (1) \$8,300,000 for renovation of the Paul Green Theatre;
- (2) \$12,000,000 for renovation and addition to the School of Law;
- (3) \$7,100,000 for renovation of the Music Library in Hill Hall; and
- (4) \$700,000 for planning for renovation of the Institute of Government.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
