A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FOR THE AID TO
2 PUBLIC LIBRARIES FUND.

4 Whereas, North Carolina's public libraries provide valuable services to all the
5 people of the State; and

6 Whereas, it is the stated purpose of the General Assembly to provide an Aid
7 to Public Libraries Fund; and

8 Whereas, it is the purpose of the Aid to Public Libraries Fund established in
9 G.S. 125-7 to improve, stimulate, increase, and equalize public library service to the
10 people of the whole State; and

11 Whereas, the Aid to Public Libraries Fund has made a positive impact in
12 providing quality public library services; Now, therefore,
13 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

14 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
15 Cultural Resources the sum of eleven million five hundred thousand dollars
16 (\$11,500,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of eleven million five hundred
17 thousand dollars (\$11,500,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to be allocated to the Aid to
18 Public Libraries Fund.

19 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
