A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE FEES FOR REGISTRANTS UNDER THE
CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 90-100 reads as rewritten:

"§ 90-100. ~~Rules and regulations.~~ Rules.

The Commission ~~is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations~~ may adopt rules, including rules to set registration fees, relating to the registration and control of the manufacture, distribution, security, and dispensing of controlled substances within this State. Fees collected pursuant to this section shall be applied to the costs of administering this Article."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1993, and applies to fees for registrations on or after that date.
