1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT EITHER SPOUSE MAY DIRECT A LENDER TO
3	CEASE MAKING ADVANCES ON AN EQUITY LINE OF CREDIT SECURED
4	BY REAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE SPOUSES AS JOINT TENANTS OR
5	TENANTS BY THE ENTIRETY.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	Section 1. G.S. 45-81(b) reads as rewritten:
8	"(b) As used in subdivision (a)(1) of this section, 'lender is obligated' means that
9	the lender is contractually bound to provide advances. The contract must shall set forth
10	any events of default by the borrower, or other events not within the lender's control,
11	which may relieve the lender from his-the lender's obligation, and must-shall state
12	whether or not the lender has reserved the right to cancel or terminate the obligation. If
13	the borrowers are a husband and wife who own the real property securing the line of
14	credit as joint tenants or tenants by the entirety, the contract shall state that the lender
15	shall cease providing advances upon written direction by one of the spouses. The
16	contract shall provide for reinstatement of credit privileges only upon written request of
17	both spouses if the borrowers are otherwise in compliance with the contract."
18	Sec. 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 1994, and applies to contracts
19	entered into on or after that date.
