SENATE BILL 797

Short Title: Mecklenburg Hours of Operation.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO MODIFY THE HOURS OF SALES OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN
MECKLENBURG COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 18B-1004(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Hours. – Except as otherwise provided in this section, it shall be unlawful to sell malt beverages, unfortified wine, fortified wine, or mixed beverages between the hours of ~~2:00 A.M.~~ 3:00 A.M. and 7:00 A.M., or to consume any of those alcoholic beverages between the hours of ~~2:30 A.M.~~ 3:30 A.M. and 7:00 A.M., in any place which has been issued a permit under G.S. 18B-1001."

Sec. 2. G.S. 18B-1004(c) reads as rewritten:

"(c) Sunday Hours. – It shall be unlawful to sell or consume alcoholic beverages on any licensed premises from the time at which sale or consumption must cease on Sunday morning until ~~1:00 P.M.~~ 11:45 A.M. on that day."

Sec. 3. This act applies to all counties with a population of over 500,000 as finally determined in the latest decennial census.

Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
