Short Title: Pitt Road Naming.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW PITT COUNTY TO RENAME ALL ROADS WITHIN
UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF THE COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 153A-238(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) This section applies to Alamance, Avery, Brunswick, Burke, Cabarrus, Cleveland, Davie, Edgecombe, Halifax, Harnett, Henderson, McDowell, Moore, Nash, New Hanover, Pender, Pitt, Randolph, Sampson, Stanly, Stokes, Surry and Watauga Counties only."

Sec. 2. G.S. 153A-239.1(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) This section applies to Alamance, Avery, Brunswick, Burke, Cabarrus, Cleveland, Davie, Edgecombe, Halifax, Harnett, Henderson, McDowell, Moore, Nash, New Hanover, Pender, Pitt, Randolph, Sampson, Stanly, Stokes, Surry and Watauga Counties only."

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
