A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CRIME CONTROL AND PUBLIC SAFETY FOR DEVELOPMENT OF A STATEWIDE CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE OFFICE OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT FOR DEVELOPMENT OF A STATEWIDE INTEGRATED LAW ENFORCEMENT COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to develop a system that links together criminal data in existing databases and networks.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of Budget and Management the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to develop a statewide integrated law enforcement communications system and to study the costs to local governments.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
