The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 130A-315(c) reads as rewritten: The drinking water rules may be amended as necessary in accordance with "(c) required federal regulations. The Commission shall not adopt rules creating any drinking water standard, limitation, or drinking water testing requirement more restrictive than the most nearly applicable federal standard, limitation, or testing requirement." Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
