February 23, 1995 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT AUTHORIZING LIMITED PURCHASING OF GOODS AND SERVICES FROM NONCERTIFIED SOURCES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Article 3 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended by adding the following new section: "§143-55.1. Purchases from other sources. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 143-55, a State agency, public school unit, or community college may purchase from a local vendor the same good or service that is listed on a State requirements contract, when the local vendor is not certified on the State requirement contract for that good or service, subject to the following conditions: The cost of the goods or services from the local vendor, including the (1) delivery costs and administrative costs incurred in negotiating, preparing, and executing the contract with the local vendor, is less than the cost under the State term contract.

The cost of the purchase does not exceed the bid value benchmark

established pursuant to G.S. 143-53.1.
