1                                   A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FUNDS TO THE NATIONAL GUARD FOR THE REPAIR  
3 AND MAINTENANCE OF ARMORIES AND FOR THE EDUCATIONAL  
4 ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6             Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of  
7 Crime Control and Public Safety the sum of four hundred thirty-nine thousand seven  
8 hundred fourteen dollars (\$439,714) for the 1995-96 fiscal year for the repair and  
9 maintenance budget for the National Guard.

10            Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of  
11 Crime Control and Public Safety the sum of six hundred eighty-six thousand four  
12 hundred sixty-seven dollars (\$686,467) for the 1995-96 fiscal year to increase the amount  
13 and number of educational assistance benefits for members of the National Guard.

14            Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
