Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety the sum of four hundred thirty-nine thousand seven hundred fourteen dollars (\$439,714) for the 1995-96 fiscal year for the repair and maintenance budget for the National Guard.

- Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety the sum of six hundred eighty-six thousand four hundred sixty-seven dollars (\$686,467) for the 1995-96 fiscal year to increase the amount and number of educational assistance benefits for members of the National Guard.
 - Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
