- (1) Review constitutional and legal issues relating to takings and compensation including recent court decisions, Congressional action, and legislation in other states.
- (2) Examine alternative methods for determining diminution of value.
- (3) Evaluate what diminution in value should entitle a landowner to compensation.
- (4) Determine whether and to what extent local governments and other governmental entities should be required to compensate.
- (5) Evaluate which types of governmental action should give rise to a claim for compensation as a regulatory taking.
