3	VACCINES AND THE ADMINISTRATION OF VACCINES WHERE
4	INSURANCE COVERAGE IS PROVIDED.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. G.S. 130A-433 reads as rewritten:
7	"§ 130A-433. Contracts for purchase of vaccines; distribution; fee; rules.
8	(a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the Secretary may enter into contracts
9	with the manufacturers and suppliers of covered vaccines and with other public entities
10	either within or without the State for the purchase of covered vaccines and may provide
11	for the distribution or sale of the covered vaccines to health care providers. Local health
12	departments shall distribute the covered vaccines at the request of the Department. The
13	Secretary shall adopt rules to implement this Article except for subsection (b) of this
14	section.
15	(b) A health care provider who receives vaccine from the State may charge no
16	more than a reasonable fee established by the Commission for Health Services for the
17	administration of the vaccine. vaccine and may not provide this vaccine to patients who
18	have health insurance coverage for the full cost of these immunizations. As used in this
19	subsection, the term 'health insurance coverage' does not apply to or include Medicaid

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- 1 <u>coverage</u>. Vaccines provided by the State to local health departments for administration
- 2 shall be administered at no cost to the patient."
- 3 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
