5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 12 of Chapter 160A of
7	the General Statutes, the Town of Maxton may convey at private sale, with or without
8	monetary consideration, any or all of its right, title, and interest in the Patterson Building
9	property, consisting of an historic flatiron structure and land located in the Town of
10	Maxton, and more particularly described in a deed recorded at Book 873, Page 530 of the
11	Robeson County Registry, to The Historic Preservation Foundation of North Carolina,
12	Inc., a nonprofit corporation.
13	Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
