1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO EXPAND THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE FORESTRY COUNCIL OF
3	THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH, AND NATURAL
4	RESOURCES AND REDEFINE ITS RESPONSIBILITIES, AS RECOMMENDED
5	BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW COMMISSION.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	Section 1. G.S. 143B-308 reads as rewritten:
8	"§ 143B-308. Forestry Council – creation; powers and duties.
9	There is hereby created the Forestry Council of the Department of Environment,
10	Health, and Natural Resources. The Forestry Council shall have the following functions
11	and duties:
12	(1) To advise the Secretary of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources
13	with respect to all matters concerning the conservation and development
14	of both state-owned and privately-owned forests in the State, including,
15	the promotion of a more profitable use of forestlands; protection,
16	management, and preservation of State-owned, privately owned, and
17	municipally owned forests in the State, including but not limited to:
18	<u>a.</u> <u>Profitable use of the State's forests consistent with the principles</u>
19	of sustained productivity.

1		b. Best management practices, including those for protection of
2		soil, water, wildlife, and wildlife habitat, to be used in managing
3		the State's forests and their resources.

7	(2)	To undertake such studies and make such reports to the Secretary of
8		Environment, Health, and Natural Resources as the Secretary may

12		and sustainability of North Carolina's forest resources, and to report
13		regularly on progress made toward meeting the objectives of the plan.

16		To provide a forum for the identification, discussion, and development
17		of recommendations for the resolution of conflicts in the management of

10	(b) The Governor shall appoint one person from categories (1) and (5), two

12	The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall appoint the person from category (2) and
12	one person each from categories (1), (4), and (5). The Speaker of the House of
13	Representatives shall appoint the person from category (3) and one person each from
15	categories (1), (4), and (5). The Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and
16	the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall consult with one another to insure that
17	each of the three geographic regions of the State are represented in appointments made to
18	fill categories (1) and (4).
19	(c) The Governor shall designate one member of the Council to serve as chairman
20	<u>chairperson</u> at the pleasure of the Governor.
20	(d) The initial members of the Council shall be appointed as follows: five
22	members for two-year terms and six members for four-year terms. At the end of the
23	respective terms of office of the initial members of the Council, the appointments of all
24	members shall be for terms of four years and until their successors are appointed and
25	qualify. Members shall serve staggered terms of office of four years. The terms of office
26	of members filling categories (1), (4), and (5) shall expire on 30 June of years that follow
27	by one year those years that are evenly divisible by four. The terms of office of members
28	filling categories (2), (3), (6), (7), (8), (9), and (10) shall expire on 30 June of years that
29	follow by three years those years that are evenly divisible by four. Terms shall expire as
30	provided by this subsection except that members of the Council shall serve until their
31	successors are appointed and duly qualified as provided by G.S. 128-7. Any appointment
32	to fill a vacancy on the Council created by the resignation, dismissal, death or disability
33	of a member shall be for the balance of the unexpired term. term and shall be made by the
34	appointing authority responsible for that category. Vacancies in appointments made by
35	the General Assembly shall be filled in accordance with G.S. 120-122.
36	(e) The Governor shall have the power to remove any member of the Council from
37	office in accordance with the provisions of G.S. 143B-16 of the Executive Organization
38	Act of 1973. The Governor shall have the power to remove, in accordance with G.S.
39	143B-13, any member appointed by the Governor. The General Assembly shall have the
40	power to remove, in accordance with G.S. 143B-13, any member appointed by the
41	General Assembly.
42	(f) Members of the Council shall receive per diem and necessary travel and
13	subsistence expenses in accordance with the provisions of $G = 138-5$

A majority of the Council shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of 1 (g) 2 business.

3 All clerical and other services required by the Council <u>Council</u>, including the (h) 4 support required to carry out studies it is requested to make, shall be supplied by the 5 Secretary of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources."

Sec. 3. G.S. 143B-310 reads as rewritten:

7 "§ 143B-310. Forestry Council – meetings.

8 The Forestry Council shall meet at least semiannually annually in October and at least 9 three other times a year and may hold special meetings at any time and place within the 10 State at the call of the chairman chairperson or upon the written request of at least a majority of the members. At least one meeting during each two-year period shall be held 11 12 in the Mountains, Piedmont, and the Coastal Plain."

13 Sec. 4. Article 2B of Chapter 113 of the North Carolina General Statutes is 14 repealed.

15 Sec. 5. The Forestry Council as it is constituted at the time this act becomes 16 effective shall be replaced by the Forestry Council as it is reconstituted by this act. 17 Persons who are members of the Forestry Council at the time this act becomes effective 18 are eligible for appointment to the reconstituted Forestry Council. To provide for 19 staggered terms, initial appointments to categories (2), (3), (6), (7), (8), (9), and (10), as 20 provided in G.S. 143B-309(a), as amended by Section 2 of this act shall expire on 30 21 June 1999. Initial appointments to categories (1), (4), and (5), as provided in G.S. 143B-

309(a), as amended by Section 2 of this act, shall expire on 30 June 1997. 22 23

Sec. 6. This act is effective upon ratification.
