A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO SPECIFY THAT ONE MEMBER OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT COMMISSION SHALL HAVE EMPLOYMENT EXPERIENCE IN INDUSTRIAL AIR AND WATER POLLUTION CONTROL AT AN INDUSTRIAL MANUFACTURING FACILITY, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW COMMISSION. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 143B-283(a) reads as rewritten:
"(a) The Environmental Management Commission shall consist of 13 members appointed by the Governor. The Governor shall select the members so that the membership of the Commission shall consist of:
 (1) One who shall be a licensed physician with specialized training and experience in the health effects of environmental pollution; (2) One who shall, at the time of appointment, be actively connected with the Commission for Health Services or local board of health or have
experience in health sciences; (3) One who shall, at the time of appointment, be actively connected with or have had experience in agriculture;
