7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:			
8	Section 1. The purpose of this act is to authorize the construction by certain			
9	constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina and the University of North			
10	Carolina Hospitals at Chapel Hill, of the capital improvements projects listed in the ac			
11	for the respective institutions, and authorize the financing of these projects with funds			
12	available to the institutions from gifts, grants, receipts, including patient receipts at the			
13	University of North Carolina Hospitals at Chapel Hill, self-liquidating indebtedness, or			
14	other funds, or any combination of these funds, but not including funds appropriated from			
15	the General Fund of the State.

31	Sec. 3. At the request of The University of North Carolina Board of Governors			
32	and upon determining that it is in the best interest of the State to do so, the Director of the			
33	Budget may authorize an increase or decrease in the scope of or a change in the method			
34	of funding the project authorized by this act. In making a determination of whether to			

authorize a change in scope or funding, the Director of the Budget may consult with the
Advisory Budget Commission. In no event may appropriations from the General Fund be
used for a project authorized by this act.
