SENATE BILL 240

Short Title: Let DOT Dredge for Local Gov't.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO
PERFORM DREDGING SERVICES FOR UNITS OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Article 6 of Chapter 136 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 136-82.3. Authority to perform dredging services.

The Department of Transportation may perform dredging services, on a cost-reimbursement basis, for a unit of local government if the unit cannot obtain the services from a private company at a cost that the unit can afford. A unit of local government is considered to be unable to obtain dredging services at a cost it can afford if it solicits bids for the dredging services in accordance with Article 8 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes and does not receive a responsible bid to perform the services for the amount of funds available to the unit to pay for the services."

Sec. 2. G.S. 66-58(c) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

"(16) The performance by the Department of Transportation of dredging services for a unit of local government."

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
