1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO AMEND THE DEFINITION OF PODIATRY.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4 Section 1. G.S. 90-202.2 reads as rewritten:

5 "**§ 90-202.2. 'Podiatry' defined.**

6 Podiatry as defined by this Article is the surgical or medical or mechanical treatment
7 of all ~~ailments~~ conditions of the human ~~foot,~~ foot and ankle, and their related soft tissue
8 structures, except the amputation of the entire foot ~~or toes~~ or the administration of an
9 anesthetic other than ~~local~~ and ~~except the correction of clubfoot deformity and triple~~
10 ~~arthrodesis.~~ local."

11 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
