2	AN ACT TO ALLOW THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO
3	PROVISIONALLY RESTORE THE DRIVERS LICENSE OF A PERSON
4	CONVICTED OF HABITUAL IMPAIRED DRIVING AFTER FIVE YEARS.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. G.S. 20-138.5(d) reads as rewritten:
7	"(d) A person convicted under this section shall have his license permanently
8	revoked. The Division may, however, conditionally restore the person's license after it
9	has been revoked for at least five years if he provides the Division with satisfactory proof
10	that:
11	(1) In the five years immediately preceding the person's application for a
12	restored license, he has not been convicted in North Carolina or in any
13	other state or federal court of a motor vehicle offense, an alcohol
14	beverage control law offense, a drug law offense, or any criminal
15	offense involving the consumption of alcohol or drugs;
16	(2) <u>He is not a user of alcohol or drugs; and</u>
17	(3) <u>He has complied with the requirements of G.S. 20-19(k).</u>
18	If the Division restores the person's license, it may place reasonable conditions or
19	restrictions on the person for any period up to five years from the date of restoration."
