5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. G.S. 122C-112(a) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
7	"(14) Upon the death of any Thomas S. class member as identified in Thomas
8	S. et al. vs. Britt, (C-C-82-418, Western District) not residing in a State
9	facility listed in G.S. 122C-181, investigate the circumstances leading to
10	that death. The investigation shall analyze any unusual circumstances
11	relating to the death. The Secretary shall adopt rules to implement this
12	section. The Secretary shall have access to all medical records, hospital
13	records, and records maintained by this State. Any county, or any local
14	agency necessary to carry out the purposes of this section, including
15	police investigations date, medical examiner investigative data, health
16	records, mental health records, and social services records."
17	Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and applies to deaths occurring
18	on or after this date.
