The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Article 8 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 14-34.5. Assault or affray on an emergency medical technician, emergency department nurse, or emergency department physician. Unless a person's conduct is covered under some other provision of law providing greater punishment, a person is guilty of a Class I felony if the person commits an assault or an affray on an emergency medical services technician, emergency department nurse,
