| 7 | Section 1. G.S. 22B-3 reads as rewritten: |
| 8 | "§ 22B-3. Contracts with forum selection provisions. |
| 9 | Any Except as otherwise provided in this section, any provision in a contract entered |
| 10 | into in North Carolina that requires the prosecution of any action or the arbitration of any |
| 11 | dispute that arises from the contract to be instituted or heard in another state is against |
| 12 | public policy and is void and unenforceable. This prohibition shall not apply to non- |
| 13 | consumer loan transactions. transactions or to any action or arbitration of a dispute that is |
| 14 | commenced in another state pursuant to a forum selection provision with the consent of |
| 15 | all parties to the contract at the time that the dispute arises." |
| 16 | Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and applies to any action or |
| 17 | arbitration commenced prior to or on or after that date. |
