BILL SUMMARY: The bill changes the distribution of proceeds from the charge for the followingspecial veterans plates: American Legion, Military Retirees, Partially Disabled Veterans, Pearl Harbor Survivors, Purple Heart Recipients, and Veterans of Foreign Wars. Currently, \$10 fee for these plates goes to the Special Registration Plate Account within the Highway Fund. Under the bill, half of the funds go to the Veterans Home Trust Fund within the General Fund
