Section 1. The corporate limits of the Town of Wake Forest are extended to include the following described area:

BEGINNING at a stake in the southern boundary of the Old Avenue Road, a corner of

30 minutes East 1230 feet to a stake in the Southwestern corner of the intersection of Old
