The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 105-164.13(2a) reads as rewritten: "(2a) Any of the following when purchased for use onanimals or plants, as appropriate, held or produced for commercial purposes: Remedies, vaccines, medications, veterinary supplies and a. equipment, litter materials, and feeds for animals. Rodenticides, insecticides, herbicides, fungicides, and pesticides. b. Defoliants for use on cotton or other crops. C. Plant growth inhibitors, regulators, or stimulators, including d. systemic and contact or other sucker control agents for tobacco

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997, and applies to sales made

and other crops."
