G.S. 163-130 reads as rewritten: "§ 163-130. Satellite voting places. A county board of elections may, upon approval of a request submitted in writing to the State Board of Elections, establish a plan whereby elderly or disabled voters in a precinct precinct, or residents of campus housing at an institution of higher education, may vote at designated sites within the precinct other than the regular voting place for that precinct. The State Board of Elections shall approve a county board's proposed plan if: All the satellite voting places to be used are listed in the county's written (1) request;
