5	MULTI-PRIME BIDDING, OR BOTH, FOR CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS OVER
6	FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	Section 1. G.S. 143-128 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
9	"( <u>d1</u> ) Local school administrative units; building projects over five hundred thousand
10	dollars (\$500,000) Notwithstanding subsection (d) of this section or any other
11	provision of law, when the entire cost of the building project is more than five hundred
12	thousand dollars (\$500,000), local school administrative units may accept bids under the
13	single-prime contract system, the separate-prime contract system, or both. All other
14	provisions of G.S. 143-128 which are not inconsistent with this subsection shall apply to
15	local school administrative units. Prior to deciding whether to accept bids single-prime,
16	separate-prime, or both, the local school administrative unit shall provide at least 10 days'
17	published notice, in a newspaper of general circulation in the county or counties in which
18	the unit is located, of a public hearing on the bidding method. The local school

- 1 administrative unit shall consider the public's comments in deciding which bidding
- 2 <u>method to use.</u>"
- 3 Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to bids 4 solicited on or after that date.
