13 14 Section 1. Alleghany County and the Town of Sparta may contract for the construction, procurement, and leasing of critical infrastructure needs including an electrical power substation and water and sewer line extensions related to the construction and operation of a new manufacturing plant currently under construction and scheduled for operation by September 1998. These contracts may be negotiated and signed without being subject to the requirements of G.S. 143-128, 143-129, 143-131, and 143-132.

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and expires on July 1, 1999.
