2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL
3	RESOURCES FOR TRYON PALACE HISTORIC SITES AND GARDENS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
6	Cultural Resources the sum of one million six hundred thirty-seven eight hundred fifty
7	dollars (\$1,637,850) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for Tryon Palace Historic Sites and
8	Gardens. Of those funds:
9	(1) \$332,850 shall be used to operate and maintain the Barbour Boat Works
10	site until demolition and construction work at the site are completed;
11	and
12	(2) \$1,305,000 shall be used for the environmental assessment and design
13	of the overall History Education Center Project.
14	Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
