| 11 | report within the first week of the convening of the 1999 General Assembly, and a final |
| 12 | report by October 1, 1997June 30, 1999. The reports shall address the Plan, actions and |
| 13 | resources needed to fully implement the Plan, and progress in achieving implementation |
| 14 | of the Plan to reduce the occurrence of and burden from heart disease and stroke in North |
| 15 | Carolina. The reports shall include an accounting of funds expended and anticipated |
| 16 | funding needs for full implementation of recommended plans and programs. |
| 17 | (m) Upon submission of its final report to the Governor and the 1997-1999 General |
