March 3, 1997 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO MAKE IT A FELONY TO CONCEAL MERCHANDISE BY USING A LEAD-LINED OR ALUMINUM-LINED BAG OR OTHER DEVICE THAT WILL PREVENT THE ACTIVATION OF AN ANTISHOPLIFTING CONTROL DEVICE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 14-72.1 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: "(d1) Notwithstanding subsection (e) of this section, any person who violates subsection (a) of this section by using a lead-lined or aluminum-lined bag, a lead-lined or aluminum-lined article of clothing, or a similar device to prevent the activation of any antishoplifting or inventory control device is guilty of a Class H felony." Section 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1997, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
