A JOINT RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY CONSUMER PROTECTION ISSUES.
Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring:
Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study consumer
protection issues. In conducting this study, the Commission may review the status of
recommendations made by the 1995 LRC Study Committee on Consumer Protection
Issues, and may also continue its study of issues identified by but not acted upon by the
1995 LRC Study Committee on Consumer Protection Issues.

Section 2. The Legislative Research Commission may make an interim

report to the 1997 General Assembly, 1998 Regular Session, and shall make a final report to the 1999 General Assembly.

Section 3. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
