2	AN ACT TO ALLOW THE CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM AND FORSYTH COUNTY
3	TO SERVE COMPLAINTS AND ORDERS BY PUBLICATION UPON OWNERS
4	WHOSE IDENTITIES OR WHEREABOUTS ARE KNOWN, BUT WHO CANNOT
5	BE SERVED BY THE PUBLIC OFFICER AFTER EXERCISING REASONABLE
6	DILIGENCE.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	Section 1. G.S. 160A-445(a) reads as rewritten:
9	"(a) Complaints or orders issued by a public officer pursuant to an ordinance
10	adopted under this Part shall be served upon persons either personally or by registered or
11	certified mail. If the identities of any owners or the whereabouts of persons are unknown
12	and cannot be ascertained by the public officer in the exercise of reasonable diligence, or
13	the identities or whereabouts of the owners or persons are known and the public officer,
14	after exercising reasonable diligence, is unable to serve the complaint or order, and the
15	public officer makes an affidavit to that effect, then the serving of the complaint or order
16	upon the unknown owners or other persons may be made by publication in a newspaper
17	having general circulation in the city at least once no later than the time at which personal
18	service would be required under the provisions of this Part. When service is made by
19	publication, a notice of the pending proceedings shall be posted in a conspicuous place on
20	the premises thereby affected."

Section 2. This act applies only to the City of Winston-Salem and Forsyth
 County.

Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to complaints
or orders served on or after that date.
