- 2 AN ACT TO MAKE IT A CLASS I FELONY TO SHOOT A HORSE.
- 3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4 Section 1. Article 23 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by 5 adding a new section to read:

6 "<u>§ 14-163.2. Shooting a horse.</u>

Notwithstanding G.S. 14-360 or G.S. 14-366, if any person willfully and unlawfully
shoots a horse that is the property of another, the person is guilty of a Class I felony."

9 Section 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1997, and applies to 10 offenses committed on or after that date.
