A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO MAINTAIN A DATABASE OF DOWNTOWN PROPERTIES AVAILABLE FOR INDUSTRIAL RECRUITMENT.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  Section 1. G.S. 143B-431 is amended by adding a new subsection (c1) to read:  "(c1) The Department of Commerce may receive and maintain a computerized database of appropriate properties (urban and rural) available for industrial recruitment and shall make information contained in the database available to the public including
industry, municipalities, and counties."  Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997 and any costs necessary to implement Section 1 of this act shall be met from funds already available to the Department of Commerce.
