H 1 **HOUSE BILL 1328** Short Title: Broughton Hospital Funds. (Public) Sponsors: Representatives Church, Alexander; and Buchanan. Referred to: Appropriations. April 23, 1999 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR EQUIPMENT AND TO RESURFACE THE STREETS AND PARKING AREAS AT BROUGHTON HOSPITAL. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health, and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, the sum of three hundred forty-five thousand dollars (\$345,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year for equipment and capital improvements at Broughton Hospital. These funds shall be allocated as follows: \$80,000 to replace dental X-ray equipment. (1) \$90,000 to purchase new ultrasound equipment. (2) \$175,000 to resurface the streets and parking areas on the hospital's (3) campus. Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
