14 15 Section 1. Funds received by the North Carolina Commission of Indian Affairs pursuant to the lease executed between the State of North Carolina and the Riverside Golf Course in Robeson County may be expended for repairs, renovations, or other capital improvements to the leased property. The Department of Administration and the Commission of Indian Affairs shall develop a procedure by which the Riverside Golf Course can apply to the Commission for the use of funds deposited with the Commission pursuant to the lease for any proposed repairs, renovations, or other capital improvements to the property.

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
