**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO  
STUDY THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN AUXILIARY POLICE OFFICERS'  
PENSION FUND.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the need to establish an auxiliary police officers' pension fund in North Carolina.

Section 2. The Legislative Research Commission may report its findings and any recommendations to the 2001 General Assembly.

Section 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the General Assembly the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to fund the study authorized in this act.

Section 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 2000.
