A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT TO UPDATE AND MAKE TECHNICAL CHANGES TO THE  
COMMUNITY COLLEGE LAWS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 115D-2 reads as rewritten:

**"§ 115D-2. Definitions.**

As used in this Chapter:

...

(2) The term "community college" is defined as an educational institution operating under the provisions of this Chapter and dedicated primarily to the educational needs of the service area which it serves, and may offer

- a. The freshmen and sophomore courses of a college of arts and sciences, authorized by G.S. 115D-4.1;
- b. Organized credit curricula for the training of technicians; curricular courses may carry transfer credit to a senior college or

1 university where the course is comparable in content and quality  
2 and is appropriate to a chosen course of study;

3 c. Vocational, trade, and technical specialty courses and programs,  
4 and

5 d. Courses in general adult education.

6 ~~Local boards of trustees, with concurrence of the respective county~~  
7 ~~commissioners, may, before January 1, 1988, adopt names of their~~  
8 ~~respective institutions that include the words "Community College".~~

9 (3) The term "institution" refers to any institution established pursuant to  
10 this Chapter except for the North Carolina Vocational Textile School  
11 Center for Applied Textile Technology.

12 ... "

13 Section 2. G.S. 115D-4.1(e) reads as rewritten:

14 "(e) The State Board of Community Colleges shall develop appropriate criteria and  
15 standards to regulate the operation of college transfer programs. The criteria and  
16 standards shall ~~require~~ require all college transfer programs to continue to meet the  
17 accreditation standards of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

18 (1) ~~All college transfer programs to continue to meet the accreditation~~  
19 ~~standards of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools;~~

20 (2) ~~Each community college that offers a college transfer program to have~~  
21 ~~an articulation agreement with at least one four-year college or~~  
22 ~~university for the acceptance of those courses;~~

23 (3) ~~Each community college that offers a college transfer program to~~  
24 ~~disclose to students when they register for college transfer courses the~~  
25 ~~articulation agreements the community college has with a four-year~~  
26 ~~college or university.~~

27 The State Board of Community Colleges shall report annually to the General  
28 Assembly on compliance of the community colleges with these criteria and standards."

29 Section 3. G.S. 115D-5(e) is repealed.

30 Section 4. G.S. 115D-8 is repealed.

31 Section 5. G.S. 115D-32(a)(2)a.2. reads as rewritten:

32 "2. Cost of fuel, water, power, and ~~telephones~~ telephone  
33 services."

34 Section 6. G.S. 115D-77 reads as rewritten:

35 "**§ 115D-77. Nondiscrimination policy.**

36 It is the policy of the State Board of Community Colleges and of local boards of  
37 trustees of the State of North Carolina not to discriminate among students on the basis of  
38 race, ~~gender or gender~~ national origin, origin, religion, age, or disability.

39 The State Board and each board of trustees shall give equal opportunity for  
40 employment and compensation of personnel at community colleges, without regard to  
41 race, religion, color, creed, national origin, sex, age, or ~~handicapping conditions~~ disability,  
42 except where specific age, sex or physical or mental requirements constitute bona fide  
43 occupational qualifications."

1 Section 7. G. S. 115D-2.1(d) reads as rewritten:

2 "(d) No member of the General Assembly, no officer or employee of the State, and  
3 no officer or employee of an institution under the jurisdiction of the State Board and no  
4 spouse of any of those persons, shall be eligible to serve on the State Board.  
5 Furthermore, no person who within the prior five years has been an employee of the  
6 ~~Department of Community Colleges~~Community Colleges System Office shall be eligible to  
7 serve on the State Board."

8 Section 8. G.S. 115D-3 reads as rewritten:

9 "**§ 115D-3. ~~Department of Community Colleges;~~Community Colleges System Office;**  
10 **staff.**

11 The ~~Department of Community Colleges~~Community Colleges System Office shall be a  
12 principal administrative department of State government under the direction of the State  
13 Board of Community Colleges, and shall be separate from the free public school system  
14 of the State, the State Board of Education, and the Department of Public Instruction. The  
15 State Board has authority to adopt and administer all policies, regulations, and standards  
16 which it deems necessary for the operation of the ~~Department~~System Office.

17 The State Board shall elect a President of the North Carolina System of Community  
18 Colleges who shall serve as chief administrative officer of the ~~Department of Community~~  
19 ~~Colleges~~Community Colleges System Office. The compensation of this position shall be  
20 fixed by the State Board from funds provided by the General Assembly in the Current  
21 Operations Appropriations Act.

22 The President shall be assisted by such professional staff members as may be deemed  
23 necessary to carry out the provisions of this Chapter, who shall be elected by the State  
24 Board on nomination of the President. The compensation of the staff members elected by  
25 the Board shall be fixed by the State Board of Community Colleges, upon  
26 recommendation of the President of the Community College System, from funds  
27 provided in the Current Operations Appropriations Act. These staff members shall  
28 include such officers as may be deemed desirable by the President and State Board.  
29 Provision shall be made for persons of high competence and strong professional  
30 experience in such areas as academic affairs, public service programs, business and  
31 financial affairs, institutional studies and long-range planning, student affairs, research,  
32 legal affairs, health affairs and institutional development, and for State and federal  
33 programs administered by the State Board. In addition, the President shall be assisted by  
34 such other employees as may be needed to carry out the provisions of this Chapter, who  
35 shall be subject to the provisions of Chapter 126 of the General Statutes. The staff  
36 complement shall be established by the State Board on recommendation of the President  
37 to insure that there are persons on the staff who have the professional competence and  
38 experience to carry out the duties assigned and to insure that there are persons on the staff  
39 who are familiar with the problems and capabilities of all of the principal types of  
40 institutions represented in the system. The State Board of Community Colleges shall  
41 have all other powers, duties, and responsibilities delegated to the State Board of  
42 Education affecting the ~~Department of Community Colleges~~Community Colleges System  
43 Office not otherwise stated in this Chapter."

1 Section 9. G.S. 115D-5(g) reads as rewritten:

2 "(g) Funds appropriated to the ~~Department of Community Colleges~~ Community  
3 Colleges System Office as operating expenses for allocation to the institutions  
4 comprising the North Carolina Community College System shall not be used to support  
5 recreation extension courses. The financing of these courses by any institution shall be on  
6 a self-supporting basis, and membership hours produced from these activities shall not be  
7 counted when computing full-time equivalent students (FTE) for use in budget-funding  
8 formulas at the State level."

9 Section 10. G.S. 115D-7 reads as rewritten:

10 **"§ 115D-7. Establishment of private, nonprofit corporations.**

11 The State Board of Community Colleges shall encourage the establishment of private,  
12 nonprofit corporations to support the community college system. The President of the  
13 ~~Department of Community Colleges~~ Community Colleges System with the approval of the  
14 State Board of Community Colleges, may assign employees to assist with the  
15 establishment and operation of such nonprofit corporation and may make available to the  
16 corporation office space, equipment, supplies and other related resources; provided, the  
17 sole purpose of the corporation is to support the community college system.

18 The board of directors of each private, nonprofit corporation shall secure and pay for  
19 the services of the State Auditor's Office or employ a certified public accountant to  
20 conduct an audit of the financial accounts of the corporation. The board of directors shall  
21 transmit to the State Board of Community Colleges a copy of the annual financial audit  
22 report of the private nonprofit corporation."

23 Section 11. G.S. 115D-31(c) reads as rewritten:

24 "(c) State funds appropriated to the State Board of Community Colleges for  
25 equipment and library books, except for funds appropriated to the Equipment Reserve  
26 Fund, shall revert to the General Fund 12 months after the close of the fiscal year for  
27 which they were appropriated. Encumbered balances outstanding at the end of each  
28 period shall be handled in accordance with existing State budget policies. The ~~Department~~  
29 System Office shall identify to the Office of State Budget and Management the funds that  
30 revert at the end of the 12 months after the close of the fiscal year."

31 Section 12. G.S. 115D-40 reads as rewritten:

32 **"§ 115D-40. Community College Scholarship Fund.**

33 (a) A nonreverting Community College Scholarship Fund is created in the  
34 ~~Department of Community Colleges~~ Community Colleges System Office to provide  
35 community college scholarships for needy residents of North Carolina. The State Board  
36 of Community Colleges shall adopt rules regarding administration of the Fund and  
37 eligibility for scholarships from it. The ~~Department of Community Colleges~~ Community  
38 Colleges System Office shall administer the Fund. The ~~Department of Community Colleges~~  
39 Community Colleges System Office shall make an effort to assure that the scholarships  
40 are distributed on a geographically equitable basis throughout the State among the several  
41 institutions. The principal of the Fund may not be used for any purpose; interest from the  
42 Fund may not be used for administering the Fund.

1 (b) Moneys in the Fund shall be deposited with the State Treasurer and  
2 administered under the provisions of G.S. 147-69.3. The State Treasurer shall make the  
3 interest earned on the moneys available to the ~~Department of Community Colleges~~  
4 Community Colleges System Office as needed for scholarships."

5 Section 13. G.S. 115D-58.3 reads as rewritten:

6 "**§ 115D-58.3. Provision for disbursement of State money.**

7 The deposit of money in the State treasury to the credit of the institution shall be made  
8 in monthly installments, and additionally as necessary, at such time and in such manner  
9 as may be convenient for the operation of the community college system. Before an  
10 installment is credited, the institution shall certify to the ~~Department of Community~~  
11 Colleges, Community Colleges System Office, the expenditures to be made by the  
12 institution from the State Current Fund during the month.

13 The ~~Department of Community Colleges~~ Community Colleges System Office shall  
14 determine whether the moneys requisitioned are due the institution, and upon determining  
15 the amount due, shall cause the requisite amount to be credited to the institution. Upon  
16 receiving notice from the ~~Department of Community Colleges~~ Community Colleges System  
17 Office that the amount has been placed to the credit of the institution, the institution may  
18 issue State warrants up to the amount so certified. Money in the State Current Fund and  
19 other moneys made available by the State Board of Community Colleges shall be  
20 released only on warrants drawn on the State Treasurer, signed by two officials of the  
21 institution designated for this purpose by the board of trustees."

22 Section 14. G.S. 115D-58.5(a) reads as rewritten:

23 "(a) Each institution shall establish and maintain an accounting system consistent  
24 with procedures as prescribed by the ~~Department of Community Colleges~~ Community  
25 Colleges System Office and the State Auditor, which shows its assets, liabilities, equities,  
26 revenues, and expenditures."

27 Section 15. G.S. 115D-72 reads as rewritten:

28 "**§ 115D-72. Motorcycle Safety Instruction Program.**

29 (a) There is created a Motorcycle Safety Instruction Program for the purpose of  
30 establishing statewide motorcycle safety instruction to be delivered through the  
31 ~~Department of Community Colleges~~ Community Colleges System Office. The Program  
32 may be administered by a motorcycle safety coordinator who shall be responsible for the  
33 planning, curriculum, and completion requirements of the Program. The State Board of  
34 Community Colleges may elect a motorcycle safety coordinator upon nomination of the  
35 President of the Community College System, and the compensation of the motorcycle  
36 safety coordinator shall be fixed by the State Board upon recommendation of the  
37 President of the Community College System pursuant to G.S. 115D-3. The State Board  
38 of Community Colleges may contract with an appropriate public or private agency or  
39 person to carry out the duties of the motorcycle safety coordinator.

40 (b) The Motorcycle Safety Instruction Program shall be implemented through the  
41 ~~Department of Community Colleges~~ Community Colleges System Office at institutions  
42 which choose to provide the Program. The motorcycle safety coordinator shall select and  
43 facilitate the training and certification of instructors who will implement the Program."

1 Section 16. G.S. 115D-78 reads as rewritten:

2 **"§ 115D-78. Access to information and public records.**

3 In accordance with Chapter 132 of the General Statutes, all rules, regulations and  
4 public records of the State Board of Community Colleges, the ~~Department of Community~~  
5 ~~Colleges, Community Colleges System Office,~~ and local boards of trustees shall be  
6 available for examination and reproduction on payment of fees by any person."

7 Section 17. G.S. 58-33-135(b)(7) reads as rewritten:

8 "(7) One representative from a list of two nominees submitted by the  
9 ~~Department of Community Colleges, Community Colleges System~~  
10 ~~Office."~~

11 Section 18. G.S. 58-33-135(c)(9) reads as rewritten:

12 "(9) One representative from a list of two nominees submitted by the  
13 ~~Department of Community Colleges, Community Colleges System~~  
14 ~~Office."~~

15 Section 19. G.S. 116-11 reads as rewritten:

16 **"§ 116-11. Powers and duties generally.**

17 The powers and duties of the Board of Governors shall include the following:

18 (1) The Board of Governors shall plan and develop a coordinated system of  
19 higher education in North Carolina. To this end it shall govern the 16  
20 constituent institutions, subject to the powers and responsibilities given  
21 in this Article to the boards of trustees of the institutions, and to this end  
22 it shall maintain close liaison with the State Board of Community  
23 Colleges, the ~~Department of Community Colleges, Community Colleges~~  
24 ~~System Office~~ and the private colleges and universities of the State.  
25 The Board, in consultation with representatives of the State Board of  
26 Community Colleges and of the private colleges and universities, shall  
27 prepare and from time to time revise a long-range plan for a coordinated  
28 system of higher education, supplying copies thereof to the Governor,  
29 the members of the General Assembly, the Advisory Budget  
30 Commission and the institutions. Statewide federal or State programs  
31 that provide aid to institutions or students of post-secondary education  
32 through a State agency, except those related exclusively to the  
33 community college system, shall be administered by the Board pursuant  
34 to any requirements of State or federal statute in order to insure that all  
35 activities are consonant with the State's long-range plan for higher  
36 education.

37 ...

38 (10) The Board shall collect and disseminate data concerning higher  
39 education in the State. To this end it shall work cooperatively with the  
40 ~~Department of Community Colleges, Community Colleges System Office~~  
41 and shall seek the assistance of the private colleges and universities. It  
42 may prescribe for the constituent institutions such uniform reporting  
43 practices and policies as it may deem desirable

1 ..."

2 Section 20. G.S. 120-70.81(a) reads as rewritten:

3 "(a) The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall examine, on a  
4 continuing basis, the several educational institutions in North Carolina, in order to make  
5 ongoing recommendations to the General Assembly on ways to improve public education  
6 from kindergarten through higher education. In this examination, the Committee shall:

- 7 (1) Study the budgets, programs, and policies of the Department of Public  
8 Instruction, the State Board of Education, the ~~Department of Community~~  
9 ~~Colleges, Community Colleges System Office,~~ the Board of Governors  
10 of The University of North Carolina, and the constituent institutions of  
11 The University of North Carolina to determine ways in which the  
12 General Assembly may encourage the improvement of all education  
13 provided to North Carolinians and may aid in the development of more  
14 integrated methods of institutional accountability;

15 ..."

16 Section 21. G.S. 126-5(c2)(3) reads as rewritten:

- 17 "(3) Employees of community colleges whose salaries are fixed in  
18 accordance with the provisions of G.S. 115D-5 and G.S. 115D-20, and  
19 employees of the ~~Department of Community Colleges~~ Community  
20 Colleges System Office whose salaries are fixed by the State Board of  
21 Community Colleges in accordance with the provisions of G.S. 115D-  
22 3."

23 Section 22. G.S. 143-151.9(a)(12) reads as rewritten:

- 24 "(12) One member selected from the ~~Department of Community Colleges;~~  
25 Community Colleges System Office;"

26 Section 23. G.S. 143B-6 reads as rewritten:

27 **"§ 143B-6. Principal departments.**

28 In addition to the principal departments enumerated in the Executive Organization  
29 Act of 1971, all executive and administrative powers, duties, and functions not including  
30 those of the General Assembly and its agencies, the General Court of Justice and the  
31 administrative agencies created pursuant to Article IV of the Constitution of North  
32 Carolina, and higher education previously vested by law in the several State agencies, are  
33 vested in the following principal departments:

- 34 (1) Department of Cultural Resources  
35 (2) Department of Health and Human Services  
36 (3) Department of Revenue  
37 (4) Department of Crime Control and Public Safety  
38 (5) Department of Correction  
39 (6) Department of Environment and Natural Resources  
40 (7) Department of Transportation  
41 (8) Department of Administration  
42 (9) Department of Commerce

- 1           (10) ~~Department of Community Colleges.~~ Community Colleges System  
2           Office."
- 3           Section 24. G.S. 143B-168.12(a)(1)d. reads as rewritten:  
4           "d. The President of the ~~Department of Community Colleges,~~  
5           Community Colleges System, ex officio, or the President's  
6           designee;"
- 7           Section 25. G.S. 143B-417(1)v. reads as rewritten:  
8           "v. ~~Department of Community Colleges~~ Community Colleges System  
9           Office ".
- 10          Section 26. G.S. 143B-426.9(14) reads as rewritten:  
11          "(14) The President of the ~~Department of Community Colleges,~~ Community  
12          Colleges System, ex officio; and".
- 13          Section 27. This act is effective when it becomes law.
