4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. G.S. 105-164.13(30) reads as rewritten:
6	"(30) Sales from <u>bulk</u> vending machines when sold by the owner or lessee
7	of said the machines at a price of one cent (1¢) fifty cents (50¢) or
8	less per sale. A bulk vending machine is a vending machine that
9	contains unsorted confections, nuts, or merchandise and, upon
10	insertion of a coin, dispenses them in equal portions, at random,
11	without selection by the customer."
12	Section 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1999, and applies to sales
13	made on or after that date.
