AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW FACILITY FOR THE ST. JOHN'S MUSEUM OF ART.

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to St. John's Museum of Art, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year to be used to construct a new facility for the museum. The St. John's Museum of Art is located in the City of Wilmington and is dedicated to collecting, preserving, and documenting the art of North Carolina from the 18th century to the present.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
