Powers and duties of Secretary. 6 7 The Secretary of Administration shall have power and authority, and it shall be his 8 duty, subject to the provisions of this Article: 9 10 (6)To make available to nonprofit corporations operating charitable hospitals, to local nonprofit comm licensed or approved by the Department of Health and Human Services as child placing 11 agencies, residential child-care facilities, private nonprofit rural, community, and migrant 12 health centers designated by the Office of Rural Health and Resource Development, to 13 private higher education institutions that are defined as "institutions" in G.S. 116-22(1), 14 and to counties, cities, towns, governmental entities and other subdivisions of the State 15 and public agencies thereof in the expenditure of public funds, the services of the 16 Department of Administration in the purchase of materials, supplies and equipment under 17
