A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ENDOW A CHAIR FOR THE STUDY OF
 ANOREXIA AND BULIMIA AT THE UNC MEDICAL SCHOOL.
 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of

Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of four hundred thousand dollars
(\$400,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year to be used to endow a chair for the study of
anorexia and bulimia at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill School of
Medicine, provided that the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) is raised by
The Anorexia/Bulimia Foundation of North Carolina or other private sources to match
this appropriation.
Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
