The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Section 5 of Chapter 265 of the 1995 Session Laws reads as rewritten: "Sec. 5. This act becomes effective January 1, 1996, and applies to contracts for which bids or offers are solicited on or after that date, and expires January 1, 2000. date." Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
