A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE COST-OF-LIVING INCREASES FOR MEMBERS OF THE TEACHERS' AND STATE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM, THE 3 CONSOLIDATED JUDICIAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM, THE LEGISLATIVE 4 RETIREMENT SYSTEM, AND THE LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL EMPLOYEES' 5 6 RETIREMENT SYSTEM. 7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 135-5 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: 8 9 "(fff) From and after July 1, 1999, the retirement allowance to or on account of beneficiaries whose retirement commenced on or before July 1, 1998, shall be increased 10 by two and three-tenths percent (2.3%) of the allowance payable on June 1, 1999, in 11 accordance with G.S. 135-5(o). Furthermore, from and after July 1, 1999, the retirement 12

Section 2. G.S. 135-65 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

 "(t) From and after July 1, 1999, the retirement allowance to or on account of beneficiaries whose retirement commenced on or before July 1, 1998, shall be increased by two and three-tenths percent (2.3%) of the allowance payable on June 1, 1999. Furthermore, from and after July 1, 1999, the retirement allowance to or on account of beneficiaries whose retirement commenced after July 1, 1998, but before June 30, 1999, shall be increased by a prorated amount of two and three-tenths percent (2.3%) of the allowance payable as determined by the Board of Trustees based upon the number of months that a retirement allowance was paid between July 1, 1998, and June 30, 1999."

Section 3. G.S. 120-4.22A is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(n) In accordance with subsection (a) of this section, from and after July 1, 1999, the retirement allowance to or on account of beneficiaries whose retirement commenced on or before January 1, 1999, shall be increased by two and three-tenths percent (2.3%) of the allowance payable on June 1, 1999. Furthermore, from and after July 1, 1999, the retirement allowance to or on account of beneficiaries whose retirement commenced after January 1, 1999, but before June 30, 1999, shall be increased by a prorated amount of two and three-tenths percent (2.3%) of the allowance payable as determined by the Board of Trustees based upon the number of months that a retirement allowance was paid between January 1, 1999, and June 30, 1999."

Section 4. G.S. 128-27 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(vv) From and after July 1, 1999, the retirement allowance to or on account of beneficiaries whose retirement commenced on or before July 1, 1998, shall be increased by one percent (1.0%) of the allowance payable on June 1, 1999, in accordance with subsection (k) of this section. Furthermore, from and after July 1, 1999, the retirement allowance to or on account of beneficiaries whose retirement commenced after July 1, 1998, but before June 30, 1999, shall be increased by a prorated amount of one percent (1.0%) of the allowance payable as determined by the Board of Trustees based upon the number of months that a retirement allowance was paid between July 1, 1998, and June 30, 1999."

Section 5. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
