2	AN ACT TO DIRECT THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION OVERSIGHT
3	COMMITTEE TO STUDY SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDS FOR PUBLIC SCHOOLS
4	IN LOW-WEALTH COUNTIES.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall study
7	the current formula for distributing supplemental funds for public schools in low-wealth
8	counties. In conducting this study, the Committee shall consider:
9	(1) Whether the current funding formula is an appropriate formula for
10	providing funds to enable low-wealth counties to enhance the
11	instructional program and student achievement in their schools; and
12	(2) Whether the current formula accurately measures counties' ability and
13	effort to fund public education; and
14	(3) The need for modifications to the current formula to correct any funding
15	inequities which may exist.
16	The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee may make an interim
17	report to the 1999 General Assembly, 2000 Regular Session, and shall make a final report
18	to the 2001 General Assembly.
19	Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
