**BILL SUMMARY**: To permit teachers to take personal leave time without a salary deduction for the substitute teacher. Amends GS115C 302.1(D) as title indicates. Current policy requires a \$50 deduction for each personal leave day.

### **ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:**

- 1. In FY1997-98 teachers took 59,541 personal leave days.
- 2. Assume an increase of 1,000 days per year over the FY1997-98 base year.
  - 1997-98 59,541 days
  - 1998-99 60,541 days
  - 1999-00 61,541 days
  - 2000-01 62,541 days
  - 2001-02 63,541 days
  - 2002-03 64,541 days
  - 2003-04 65,641 days
- 3. The deduction will remain at the current \$50 per day for the next four years.
- 4. Cost will be paid by the source of funds from which the teacher's salary is paid.
