- 2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT BALLOT INSTRUCTIONS BE PRINTED IN3 SPANISH AS WELL AS ENGLISH.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Article 13 of Chapter 163 of the General Statutes is amended 6 by adding a new section to read:
- 7 "<u>§ 163-140.2. Ballot instructions in English and Spanish.</u>
- 8 All instructions to the voter on ballots shall be printed in both English and Spanish.
- 9 The State Board of Elections shall prepare a Spanish translation of ballot instructions
- 10 for county boards of elections."
- 11 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective January 1, 2002.
