SECTION 1. The State Board of Elections is directed to identify the counties with outdated voting equipment that could result in election-day trouble and to rank those counties in terms of the severity of the problem.

SECTION 2. The State Board of Elections is directed to identify and pursue all available federal and other funds that become available for replacing voting equipment.

SECTION 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the State Board of Elections for the 2002-2003 fiscal year the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to match federal and other funds that are available for replacing outdated voting equipment.

SECTION 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
